I. Power for our Calling

v1-2


- Our commissioning
- The power for our calling comes from God's Spirit
- We have divine enablement through the Holy Spirit

1. And He said to me, "Son of man, stand on your feet, and I will speak to you."
2. Then the Spirit entered me when He spoke to me, and set me on my feet; and I heard Him who spoke to me.

II. Faithfulness to our **CALLING** v3-5

- Faithfulness matters more than results
- Success in God's eyes is measured by obedience, not outcomes
- Your Calling: bringing the greatest degree of glory?

3. And He said to me: "Son of man, I am sending you to the children of Israel, to a rebellious nation that has rebelled against Me; they and their fathers have transgressed against Me to this very day.
4. For they are impudent and stubborn children. I am sending you to them, and you shall say to them, 'Thus says the Lord GOD.'
5. As for them, whether they hear or whether they refuse—for they are a rebellious house—yet they will know that a prophet has been among them.



III. Encouragement for our **CALLING** v6-7

- Opposition is expected
- Rejection and resistance are part of walking in divine calling


6. "And you, son of man, do not be afraid of them nor be afraid of their words, though briers and thorns are with you and you dwell among scorpions; do not be afraid of their words or dismayed by their looks, though they are a rebellious house.
7. You shall speak My words to them, whether they hear or whether they refuse, for they are rebellious.

IV. Embody our **CALLING**

v8-10

- We must embody what we preach
- Living the Word makes our witness credible

8. But you, son of man, hear what I say to you. Do not be rebellious like that rebellious house; open your mouth and eat what I give you."
9. Now when I looked, there was a hand stretched out to me; and behold, a scroll of a book was in it.
10. Then He spread it before me; and there was writing on the inside and on the outside, and written on it were lamentations and mourning and woe.



Practical Applications

- **Seek Your Calling:** Determine to pray and ask God, "How did You create me to bring You glory? What is my divine calling?"
- **Study to Embody:** Choose one passage of Scripture to "eat" this week. Read it daily, memorize it, pray through it, and ask God how to live it out.
- **Faithful Despite Results:** Identify one area where you've been discouraged by lack of visible results. Commit to continue being faithful for the next month, trusting God with the outcomes.



Practical Applications

- **Encourage Someone in Their Calling:** Think of someone you know who is faithfully living out their calling despite opposition.
- **Stand Firm:** Identify one area where you've been tempted to "go with the flow" of culture rather than stand for God's Word. Make a specific plan for how you'll stand firm this week.



Your Divine Calling

- Have you identified your divine Calling?
 - CALLING blesses others, yourself, and ultimately God
- Embrace your divine calling through complete reliance on His Spirit, stepping boldly into the CALLING God has prepared for you.
 - CALLING changes and refocus through stages and stations of life
