Healthy Speech – The How

1. Examine your words

Proverbs 18:21

Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit.

Matthew 12:36

But I say to you that for every <u>idle</u> word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment.

Healthy Speech – The How

2. Limit your Words

Proverbs 10:19

In the multitude of words sin is not lacking, But he who restrains his lips is wise.

Proverbs 17:27

He who has knowledge spares his words, And a man of understanding is of a calm spirit.

Proverbs 15:28

The heart of the righteous studies how to answer, But the mouth of the wicked pours forth evil.
