

#1-By derailing your relationship w/ God

#2 - By modeling a life that dishonors God

Proverbs 3:35 - The wise will inherit honor, But fools display dishonor.

Proverbs 13:16 - Every prudent man acts with knowledge, But a fool displays folly.

3 John 1:11 - Beloved, do not imitate what is evil, but what is good. The one who does good is of God; the one who does evil has not seen God.

- Immodest Clothing




#3 - By advising you with their folly instead of God's Word

Proverbs 15:2 - The tongue of the wise makes knowledge acceptable, But the mouth of fools spouts folly.

Proverbs 12:15 - The way of a fool is right in his own eyes, But a wise man is he who listens to counsel.

* Esther 5:9-14



#4-By pressuring you to violate God's commands

Proverbs 14:9 - Fools mock at sin, But among the upright there is good will.

Proverbs 1:7 - The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge; Fools despise wisdom and instruction.

Proverbs 1:22 - "How long, O naive ones, will you love being simpleminded? And scoffers delight themselves in scoffing And fools hate knowledge?

#5-By limiting your reach of love

Psalm 119:63 - I am a companion of all those who fear You, And of those who keep Your precepts.

1 John 4:19-21 - We love, because He first loved us. 20 If someone says, "Hove God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for the one who does not love his brother whom he has seen, cannot love God whom he has not seen. 21 And this commandment we have from Him, that the one who loves God should love his brother also.

John 13:34–35 - ""A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. """By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.""

#6-By tarnishing your testimony

2 Corinthians 6:14-18 - Do not be bound together with unbelievers; for what partnership have righteousness and lawlessness, or what fellowship has light with darkness? Or what harmony has Christ with Belial, or what has a believer in common with an unbeliever? Or what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; just as God said, "I WILL DWELL IN THEM AND WALK AMONG THEM; AND I WILL BE THEIR GOD, AND THEY SHALL BE MY PEOPLE. "Therefore, COME OUT FROM THEIR MIDST AND BE SEPARATE," says the Lord. "AND DO NOT TOUCH WHAT IS UNCLEAN; And I will welcome you. "And I will be a father to you, And you shall be sons and daughters to Me," Says the Lord Almighty.
