Definition: to refute falsehood; to tell people they are wrong or that they have done something wrong.

Definition: to give a formal, strong disapproval, to warn of an impending penalty.

- This is now the ministry of men (Acts 10, 2 Cor. 5:20, Eph. 4:11)
