

Richard Philips:

One of the earliest Greek philosophers was Heraclitus (6th c. B.C.). He thought about the fact that things constantly change. His famous illustration was that you can never step twice into the same river; it is never the same because the water has flowed on. Everything is like that, he said.

Richard Philips:

But if that is true, how can there be order in the world? His answer was the *Logos*, the *Word* or *reason* of God. This was the principle that held everything together in a world of change. There is a purpose and design to the world and events, and this is the *Logos*.

All things came into being through Him-

- John emphasizes the fact that Jesus was the Divine agent acting in conjunction with both the Father and the Spirit to create the world.
- And he does this by stating it **positively** first and then again in the **negative**.



John 1:1-5

Theme: Jesus is eternal creator God and in Him alone is eternal life.

All things came into being through Him-

- Notice how exhaustive the application of this truth is: All things...
- Jesus was not only there in the beginning before the world was, but it was Jesus who created everything in the universe.
- The universe did not come into existence by any other process than the divine activity of God speaking it into existence.



John 1:1-5

Theme: Jesus is eternal creator God and in Him alone is eternal life.

Through Him-

- Jesus was the agent who exerted His power to create all that is which includes: every star, planet, tree, flower, animal, person, and Angel.
- And in case we somehow missed the point and think that something perhaps snuck through and evolved on its own or is outside the scope of God's creation John states the same truth in the negative:

And apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being-

- Notice again the exhaustive nature of John's words, "nothing".
- So, nothing came into existence outside the creative work of,
 The Word, Who is none other than Jesus Christ.
- John is not the only one to testify to the fact that everything that exists was created by Jesus:
- Paul also teaches this truth in Colossians.

Colossians 1:16-17

¹⁶For by Him all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him. ¹⁷He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together.

John 1:1-5

Theme: Jesus is eternal creator God and in Him alone is eternal life.

- To be the creator of all things including angelic beings and every power in the universe means that Jesus has power and authority over all things.
- It means He has power and authority over you and me.
- And that we are accountable to Him as our creator, God, and judge.
- What John is doing is adding another layer to the argument for the divinity and majesty of Christ.
- The Father spoke and the Son accomplished His words!
