³You scrutinize my path and my lying down,
And are intimately acquainted with all my ways.

⁴Even before there is a word on my tongue,
Behold, O LORD, You know it all.

⁵You have enclosed me behind and before,
And laid Your hand upon me.

⁶Such knowledge is too wonderful for me;
It is too high, I cannot attain to it.

⁷Where can I go from Your Spirit?
Or where can I flee from Your presence?

Or as His counselor has informed Him? ¹⁴With whom did He consult and who gave Him understanding?

And who taught Him in the path of justice and taught Him knowledge

And informed Him of the way of understanding?

¹⁵Behold, the nations are like a drop from a bucket,
And are regarded as a speck of dust on the scales;
Behold, He lifts up the islands like fine dust. ¹⁶Even
Lebanon is not enough to burn,
Nor its beasts enough for a burnt offering. ¹⁷All the
nations are as nothing before Him,
They are regarded by Him as less than nothing and

Isaiah 40:27-31

²⁷Why do you say, O Jacob, and assert, O Israel,
“My way is hidden from the LORD,
And the justice due me escapes the notice of my
God”? ²⁸Do you not know? Have you not heard?
The Everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the
ends of the earth
Does not become weary or tired.

Isaiah 40:27-31

His understanding is inscrutable. ²⁹He gives strength to the weary,
And to him who lacks might He increases power.
³⁰Though youths grow weary and tired,
And vigorous young men stumble badly, ³¹Yet those who wait for the LORD
Will gain new strength;
