Three responses that God's authority over the gospel demands from you today:

1 – It demands our rescue (1-5)

2 – It demands our submission (6-10)

Corinthians 11:13–14 (NASB95)

2 – It demands our submission (6-10)

3 – It demands our worship (11-24)

Conclusion:

1 – Submit to the Gospel

2 – Be rescued by the Gospel

3 – Allow the Gospel to move you to worship
