¹Now after the Sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to look at the grave. ²And behold, a severe earthquake had occurred, for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven and came and rolled away the stone and sat upon it. ³And his appearance was like lightning, and his

from the dead; and behold, He is going ahead of you into Galilee, there you will see Him; behold, I have told you.”⁸ And they left the tomb quickly with fear and great joy and ran to report it to His disciples.⁹ And behold, Jesus met them and greeted them. And they came up and took hold of His feet and worshiped Him.¹⁰ Then Jesus *said to

men and put Him to death. ²⁴But God raised Him up again, putting an end to the agony of death, since it was impossible for Him to be held in its power.

¹⁸I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, ¹⁹and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe. These are in accordance with the working of the strength of His might ²⁰which He brought
