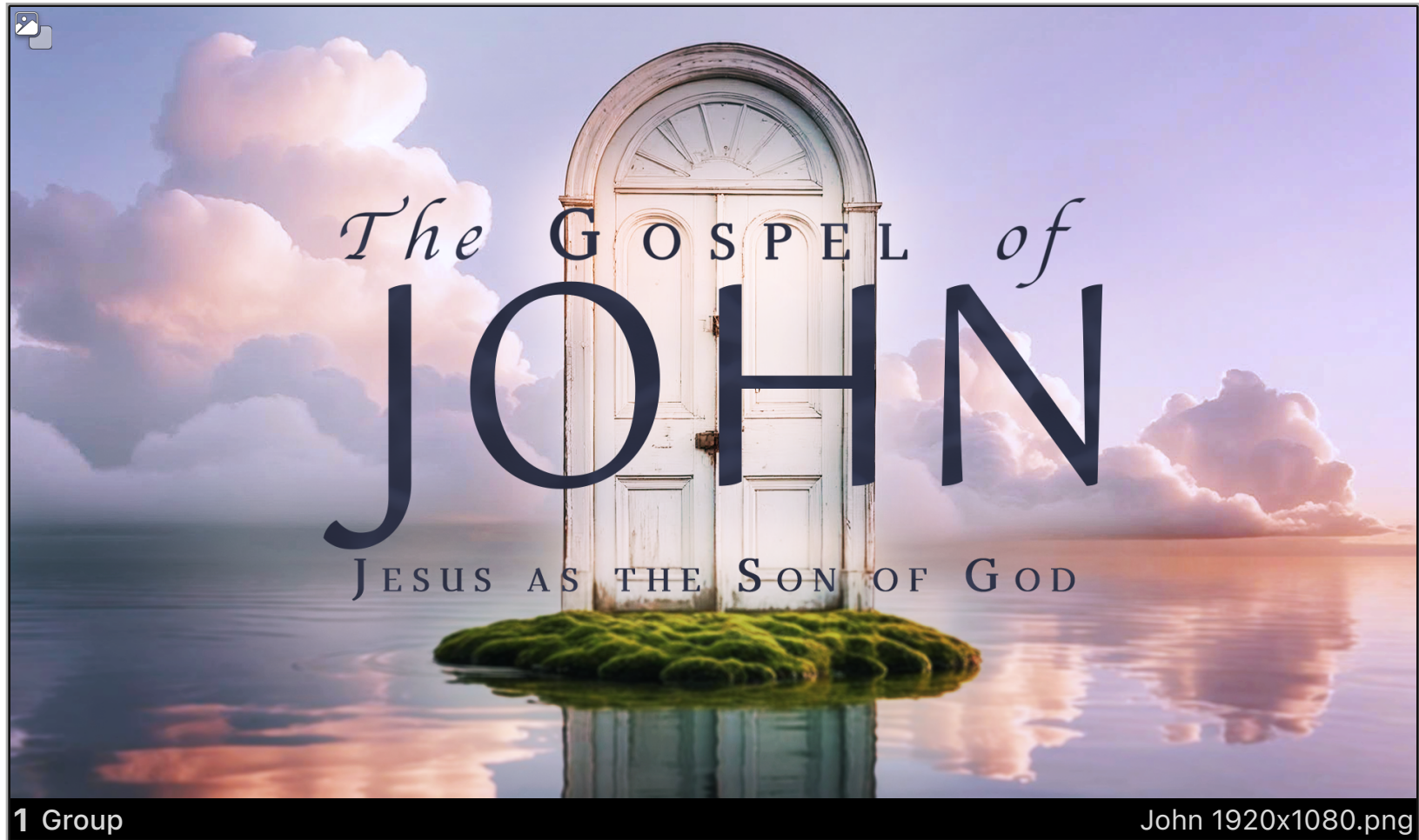

³⁷The two disciples heard him speak, and they followed Jesus. ³⁸And Jesus turned and saw them following, and *said to them, "What do you seek?" They said to Him, "Rabbi (which translated means

Teacher), where are You staying?" ³⁹He *said to them, "Come, and you will see." So they came and saw where He was staying; and they stayed with Him that day, for it was about the tenth hour.

⁴⁰One of the two who heard John speak and followed Him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother.

⁴¹He *found first his own brother Simon and *said

to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which translated means Christ). ⁴²He brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, "You are Simon the son of John; you shall be called Cephas" (which is translated Peter).

1 Corinthians 11:26-29

²⁶For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.

²⁷Therefore whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner, shall be guilty of the body and the blood of the Lord. ²⁸But a man must examine himself, and in so doing he is to eat of the bread and drink of the cup. ²⁹For he
