⁴³After the two days He went forth from there into Galilee. ⁴⁴For Jesus Himself testified that a prophet has no honor in his own country. ⁴⁵So when He came to Galilee, the Galileans received Him, having seen all the things that He did in Jerusalem at the feast; for they themselves also went to the feast. ⁴⁶Therefore He came again to Cana of Galilee

where He had made the water wine. And there was a royal official whose son was sick at Capernaum. ⁴⁷When he heard that Jesus had come out of Judea into Galilee, he went to Him and was imploring Him to come down and heal his son; for he was at the point of death. ⁴⁸So Jesus said to him, "Unless you people see signs and wonders, you

simply will not believe.”⁴⁹ The royal official *said to Him, “Sir, come down before my child dies.”⁵⁰ Jesus *said to him, “Go; your son lives.” The man believed the word that Jesus spoke to him and started off.⁵¹ As he was now going down, his slaves met him, saying that his son was living.⁵² So he inquired of them the hour when he began to get

better. Then they said to him, “Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him.”⁵³ So the father knew that it was at that hour in which Jesus said to him, “Your son lives”; and he himself believed and his whole household.⁵⁴ This is again a second sign that Jesus performed when He had come out of Judea into Galilee.

⁵And Jesus seeing their faith *said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven." ⁶But some of the scribes were sitting there and reasoning in their hearts, ⁷"Why does this man speak that way? He is blaspheming; who can forgive sins but God alone?" ⁸Immediately Jesus, aware in His spirit that they were reasoning that way within themselves, *said
