

- **Joshua 11:22 (NASB95)**
- **22** There were no Anakim left in the land of the sons of Israel; only in Gaza, in Gath, and in Ashdod some remained.





- **1 Samuel 8:20 (NASB95)**
- **20** that we also may be like all the nations, that our king may judge us and go out before us and fight our battles.”
