

of the money changers and overturned their tables; <sup>16</sup> and to those who were selling the doves He said, "Take these things away; stop making My Father's house a place of business." <sup>17</sup> His disciples remembered that it was written, "ZEAL FOR YOUR HOUSE WILL CONSUME ME." <sup>18</sup> The Jews then said to Him, "What sign do You show us as your

authority for doing these things?" <sup>19</sup>Jesus answered them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." <sup>20</sup>The Jews then said, "It took forty-six years to build this temple, and will You raise it up in three days?" <sup>21</sup>But He was speaking of the temple of His body. <sup>22</sup>So when He was raised from the dead, His disciples remembered that He said

this; and they believed the Scripture and the word which Jesus had spoken. <sup>23</sup>Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, during the feast, many believed in His name, observing His signs which He was doing. <sup>24</sup>But Jesus, on His part, was not entrusting Himself to them, for He knew all men, <sup>25</sup>and because He did not need anyone to testify

concerning man, for He Himself knew what was in man.
