### **Youth-giving**

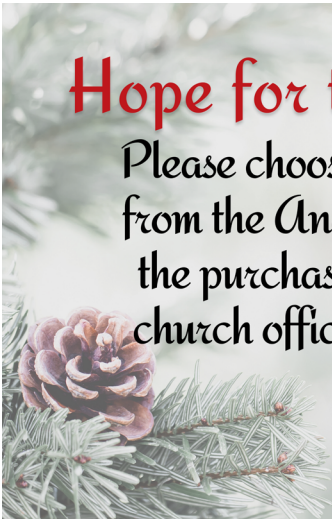
