Marriage expectations are changing among Generation Z and millennials, with two in five people surveyed stating they believe marriage is an outdated tradition, according to a <u>new survey</u> from the Thriving Center of Psychology.

While the traditional ideas surrounding marriage may be shifting, 83% of participants said they would like to get married at some point. Though, 85% also reported that they don't feel marriage is needed to "have a fulfilling and committed relationship."

Over 1 in 6 said they do not plan on getting married, with 17% of millennials and 7% of Gen Z feeling this way, according to the poll.

The report found the cost and current economy appears to be a barrier for young adults, with 73% stating they felt it's too expensive to get married.
