Title: "Undisputed"

Subtitle: "Understanding the Process: Receiving My Resurrection"

Scripture: Romans 6:4-5 AMPC

Read Romans 6:4-5 AMPC 4 We were buried therefore with Him by the baptism into death, so that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glorious [power] of the Father, so we too might [habitually] live and behave in newness of life. 5 For if we have become one with Him by sharing a death like His, we shall also be [one with Him in sharing] His resurrection [by a new life lived for God].

Introduction

We learned that Jesus did not come to fix our problems but to transform us through the power of His resurrection. Tonight, we will continue to understand that Jesus is the Undisputed King, as we learn to embrace the process of the resurrection.

Everything God does is a re-job (Redeem, Reconcile, Restore, and Resurrection).

Read Hosea 14:1-2 NIV (sin is any movement away from God)

1 Return, Israel, to the Lord your God. Your sins have been your downfall! 2

Take words with you and return to the Lord. Say to him: "Forgive all our sins and receive us graciously, that we may offer the fruit of our lips.

Re- to go back to the original condition and relationship of a thing.

Re-deem - Deem to own, to possess, to have!

 You cannot redeem something that was not first owned <u>before</u>. (You cannot redeem yourself, you never owned you!)

Read Titus 2:13-14 NIV 13 while we wait for the blessed hope—the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ, 14 who gave himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness and to purify for himself a people that are his very own, eager to do what is good.

· Redemption is the act of being owned Twice.

Read Hebrews 9:22 APMC 22 [In fact] under the Law almost everything is purified by means of blood, and without the shedding of blood there is neither

release from sin and its guilt nor the remission of the due and merited punishment for sins.

Blood in the Bible is a word for life and death.

Re-concile - to restore to **oneness**, to bring two things back **together** again.

Read Colossians 1:19-22 NIV 19 For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, 20 and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross. 21 Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of[a] your evil behavior. 22 But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation—

 All of our <u>stupid</u> behaviors and <u>dumb</u> decisions have been cleansed and made us <u>guilt-free</u> through His blood and death on the cross!

Re-store - Store means **full**, complete, and equipped.

• Restore - to make full again to replace what was removed.

Read Jeremiah 30:17-18 NIV But I will restore you to health and heal your wounds,' declares the Lord, 'because you are called an outcast, Zion for whom no one cares.' 18 "This is what the Lord says: "I will restore the fortunes of Jacob's tents and have compassion on his dwellings; the city will be rebuilt on her ruins, and the palace will stand in its proper place.

 The fact is there are things <u>missing</u> in us that only <u>Christ</u>, through His resurrection, can fill again.

Re-surrection (Anastasis) - a standing <u>up</u> again, to be made <u>alive</u> again, to come out of what you were in, to become <u>who</u> you were originally meant to be!!!!

Read John 11:25-26 APMC 25 Jesus said to her, I am [Myself] the Resurrection and the Life. Whoever believes in (adheres to, trusts in, and relies on) Me, although he may die, yet he shall live; 26 And whoever continues to live and believes in (has faith in, cleaves to, and relies on) Me shall never [actually] die at all. Do you believe this?

Jeremiah 15:19 NIV Therefore this is what the Lord says: "If you repent, I will restore you that you may serve me; if you utter worthy, not worthless, words, you will be my spokesman.....
