150 Days of Prevailing Waters

- **Iyyar 10** God gives “7-day Warning” (7:1-10)
- **Iyyar 17** The Flood Begins (7:11)

Iyyar 17 — Siwan 27 Rain falls for 40 days (7:12)

Iyyar 17 Noah & co. enter the Ark (7:13-16)

Iyyar 17 — Siwan 27 All flesh blotted out (7:21-23)

Iyyar 17 — Tishri 17 Water prevails upon the earth 150 days (7:24)

Siwan 27 — Tishri 17 God ends the Flood, waters diminish 110 more days until “decreased” at the end of 150 days (8:1-3)

- **Tishri 17** Ark rested on Ararat (8:4)

Tishri 17 — Tebheth 1 Water decreases further, mountain tops visible by Tebheth 1 (8:5)

Shebhat 10 Noah sends out the raven after 40 days (8:6-7) •

Noah sends out the dove (8:8-9) ?

7 days later, Noah sends out the dove again (8:10-11) ?

7 days later, Noah sends out the dove again (8:12) ?

Nisan 1 Noah sees the earth is dried up (8:13) •

Iyyar 27 Earth very dry, Noah & co. leave the Ark (8:14-19) •

370 days of the Flood Year (1 lunar year + 10 days)
