

# What is Baptism?

• Baptizo (Greek) = to submerge, to immerse, to dip, to overwhelm

"As Jesus came up out of the water," - Mark 1:10 NLT

"...they went down into the water...they came up out of the water..." - Acts 8:38-39 NLT

It doesn't save us!

"God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. 9 Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it." - Eph 2:8-9 NLT

It is a symbolic act

For you were buried with Christ when you were baptized. And with him you were raised to new life because you trusted the mighty power of God, who raised Christ from the dead. 13 You were dead because of your sins and because your sinful nature was not yet cut away. Then God made you alive with Christ, for he forgave all our sins. 14 He canceled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross.

- Colossians 2:12-14 NLT

## Why Should We Be Baptized?

• Because it is a public declaration of our inner transformation!

...people should be baptized to show that they had repented of their sins and turned to God to be forgiven.

- Mark 1:4 NLT

Because Jesus is our example!

One day Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee, and John baptized him in the Jordan River. - Mark 1:9 NLT

But Jesus said, "It should be done, for we must carry out all that God requires." - Matthew 3:15 NLT

Because it confirms our identity!

John announced: "Someone is coming soon who is greater than I am—so much greater that I'm not even worthy to stoop down like a slave and untie the straps of his sandals. 8 I baptize you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit!" 9 One day Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee, and John baptized him in the Jordan River. 10 As Jesus came up out of the water, he saw the heavens splitting apart and the Holy Spirit descending on him like a dove. 11 And a voice from heaven said, "You are my dearly loved Son, and you bring me great joy." - Mark 1:7-11 NLT

#### Because Jesus is Lord!

"Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. 19 Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit." - Matthew 28:18-19 NLT

"If you love me, obey my commandments." - John 14:15 NLT
