

# A Legacy of Faith

## Leaving a Legacy - Week 2 Devotional

### *Day 1: The Assurance of Faith*

Reading: Hebrews 11:1-2

#### Devotional:

The foundation of our spiritual journey is faith. Hebrews 11:1 defines faith as both assurance and conviction. It's knowing deeply that what we hope for according to God's promises is real, even if we cannot see it yet. The ancestors of faith—like Abel, Enoch, and Noah—were commended not for outcomes, but for their unshakeable belief in God's promises.

#### Application:

**Reflect** on areas of your life where you might struggle to have conviction. **Identify** one promise of God that you will hold onto this week. **Write it down** and place it somewhere visible. **Pray** for greater assurance in God's unseen promises.

## ***Day 2: Faith in Creation***

Reading: Hebrews 11:3

### **Devotional:**

The account of creation speaks to the power and majesty of God. Our belief in this forms the foundation of our faith journey. It reassures us of God's sovereignty and the intentionality behind our existence. The universe wasn't a random occurrence but a divine act, a reminder that our lives have purpose and design.

### **Application:**

**Spend time in nature this week, observing creation.** Let it remind you of God's majesty and creativity. During your time, offer a prayer of gratitude for the wonder and intricacies of His creation and how that reflects His attention and care for you.

## ***Day 3: Standing Strong in Faith***

Reading: Hebrews 11:6

### **Devotional:**

Drawing near to God requires faith—faith in His existence, presence, and faithfulness. Our spiritual walk is active, not passive. It involves seeking God with intention and trust, knowing that He is good and His promises are true even amidst challenges.

### **Application:**

**Each day, take a moment to consciously draw near to God.** This could be through prayer, reading scripture, or quiet reflection. Document changes you observe in your relationship with God, and specifically note any rewards—big or small—you receive through this connection.

## ***Day 4: A Legacy of Faith***

Reading: Hebrews 11:13

### **Devotional:**

The patriarchs left a legacy not just in what they did, but in how they believed. Their lives teach us that true legacy is marked by faith in God's eternal promises. Though they did not see the fulfillment of every promise, their faith influenced generations.

### **Application:**

**Reflect** on how your current actions and beliefs are contributing to your legacy. What do you hope others see and learn from your life?

## ***Day 5: Faith and Boldness***

Reading: Hebrews 11:32-34

### **Devotional:**

These verses highlight the boldness and achievements possible through faith. Each figure faced insurmountable odds yet prevailed through trust in God's power. Their stories inspire us to embrace courage in our faith journey, knowing that God provides strength in our weakness.

### **Application:**

**Identify** an area in your life where boldness is required, whether confronting fear, addressing a challenge, or standing for truth. **Ask God for courage and wisdom. Commit** to one bold step of faith this week and record the outcome, paying attention to how God empowers you.
