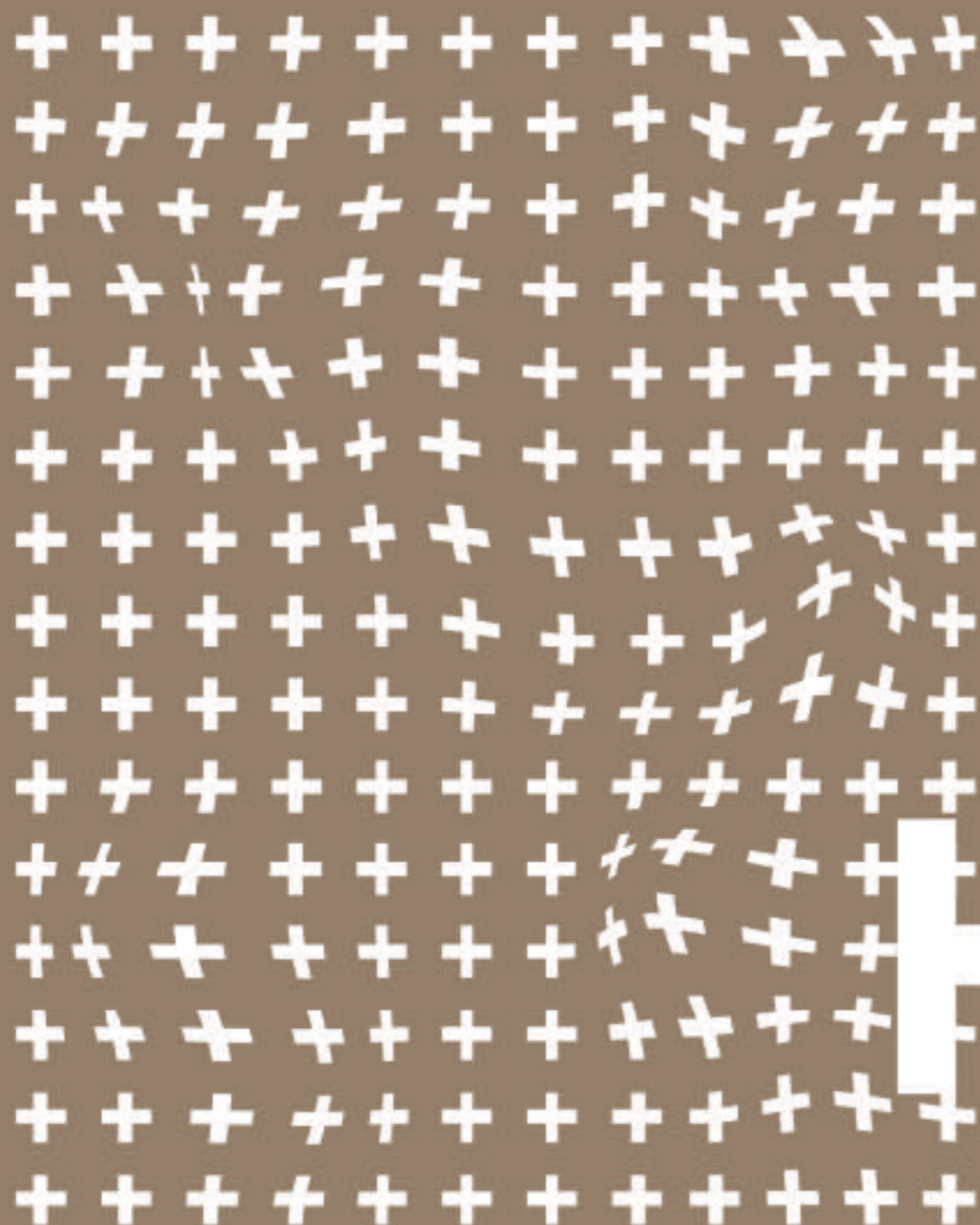

# The Book of Life

Is salvation really about my good behavior after all?

If people are not listed in the Book of Life, then each one is judged according to his works. Those who refuse to come to God by faith will, by default, be judged (and, therefore, condemned) by their works.



# The Second Death

# The Reality of Hell

**15 And anyone whose name was not found recorded in the Book of Life was thrown into the lake of fire.” - Revelation 20:15 NLT**

**“20 Then Jesus began to denounce the towns where he had done so many of his miracles, because they hadn’t repented of their sins and turned to God. 21 “What sorrow awaits you, Korazin and Bethsaida! For if the miracles I did in you had been done in wicked Tyre and Sidon, their people would have repented of their sins long ago, clothing themselves in burlap and throwing ashes on their heads to show their remorse. 22 I tell you, Tyre and Sidon will be better off on judgment day than you.” - Matthew 11:20-22 NLT**



# 1. We Don't Escape God's Judgment; We Satisfy it in Jesus!

“What we have confessed, what we have admitted to God as sin and sought mercy for, has been erased. You should see the book on me! It is very messy. No, you shouldn't see the book on me, although it is likely not all that different from the book on you. Line after line, entry after entry, failure-to-trust-Jesus-after-failure-to-trust-Jesus, inappropriate way of dealing with inner pain after inappropriate way of dealing with inner pain. Line after line, erased, crossed over, crossed out! 1 John 1:8 — “If we say we have no sin, we are deceiving ourselves, and the truth is not in us.” 1 John 1:9 — But “If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”
