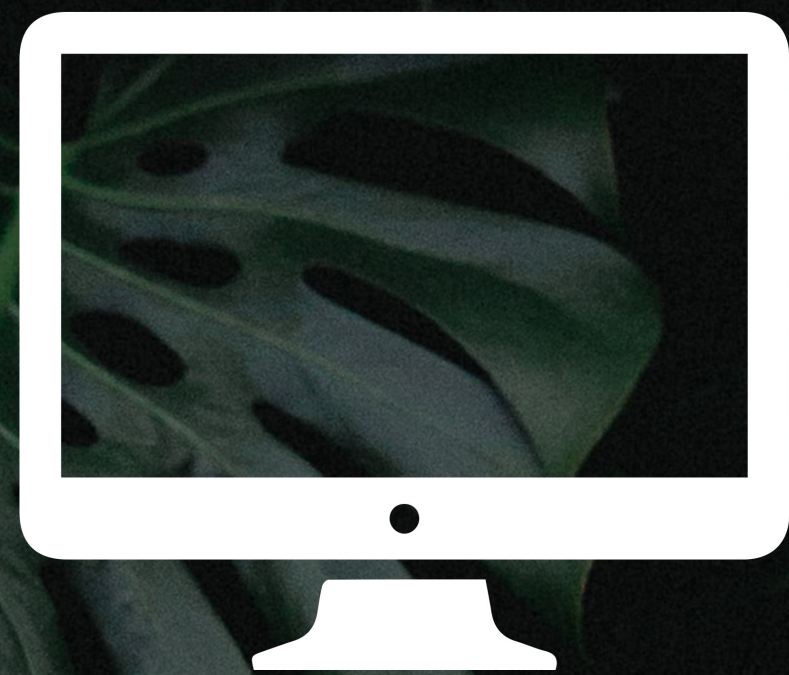

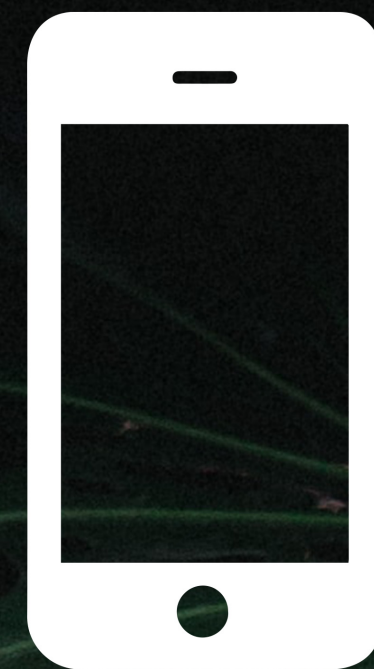

# Can Jesus Build His Kingdom in Your Life?



“Think for a moment what you’ve filled your room with, both good and bad. Activities like careers or bowling or fly fishing. Attitudes you’ve experienced, like worry, anger frustration, joy, or empathy. Some of these things are good and beautiful and lasting. Others are trespassers in your life. Jesus isn’t going to be satisfied standing outside your door knocking while you try and tidy up before letting Him in. God doesn’t want us to invite Him to sit quietly in a corner like a celebrity guest either. He’s not our concierge or our butler, our muse or our roommate. Jesus is a King who came to make a kingdom, but He’s not going to try to build it on top of our stuff or around all our activities. If the room is full, we can invite Him in all we want, but we should expect that He’s likely to do major renovations than just rearrange the furniture or provide us room service. If the room is already full, He’ll just wait to come more fully into our lives when it isn’t.”
