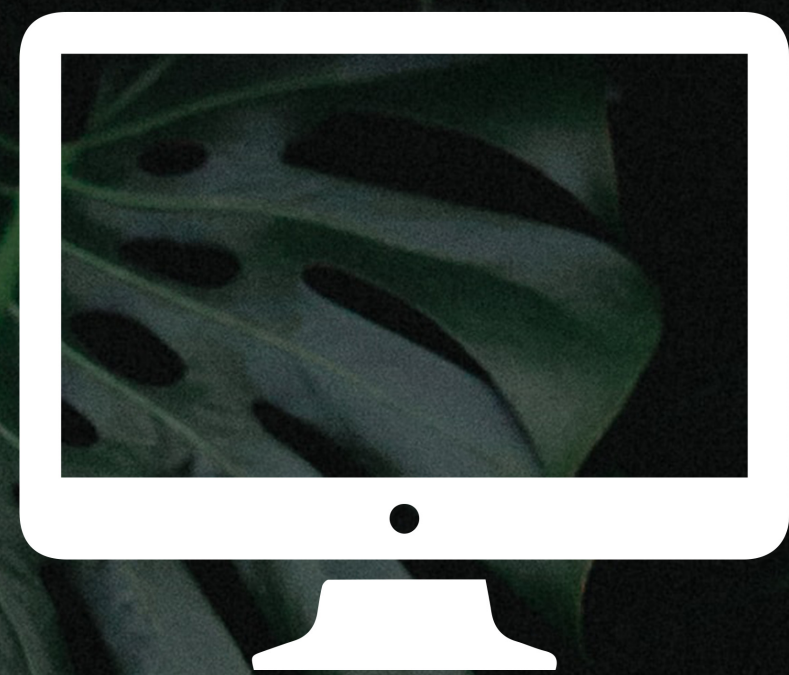

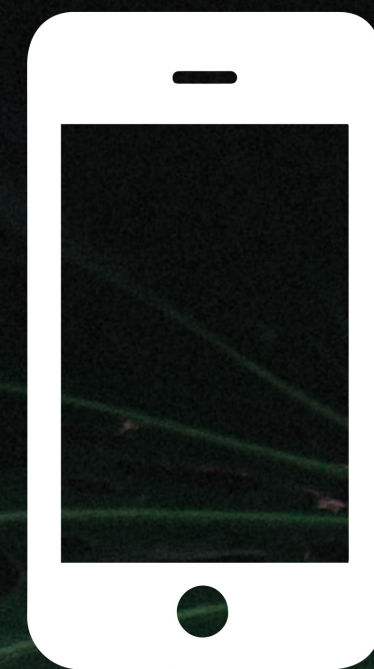

The Man With Two Sons

Today in our parable commonly called
'The Prodigal Son' you will be most
moved by The Heart of The Father.



11 To illustrate the point further,
Jesus told them this story:
A man had two sons....




2 This made the Pharisees and teachers of religious law complain that he was associating with such sinful people- even eating with them!



Why does God have such a huge heart to seek and save such lost sinners in this world?




12 The younger son told his father, “I want my share of your estate now before you die.” So his father agreed to divide his wealth between his sons.
