



Examining Motives for Ministry


I want to finish a thought from last week, and clarify The Shoreline Church's stance on our love for and partnering with para-church ministries:


Work Framework


1 Thessalonians 2:19-20

Your Pride and Joy


When you die and stand before the Lord Jesus, you will point to your PRIDE AND JOY as those whom you led to Christ, and are walking with Him on earth despite opposition.
