Tri-Unity

- We worship the One True God who has revealed Himself to us: One God in essence, eternally existent in three persons- Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The Bible makes it clear; our God is three in one.

Key Bible Passage

- Genesis 1:26, “Let us make human beings in our image, to be like us.”

Key Bible Passage

- “Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.” Deuteronomy 6:4-5 (ESV)

Key Bible Passage

- Isaiah 61:1, “The Spirit [Holy Spirit] of the Sovereign LORD [Father] is upon me, for the LORD has anointed me [Jesus] to bring good news to the poor.”

Key Bible Passage

- Luke 1:35, “The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High [Father] will overshadow you. So the baby to be born will be holy, and he will be called the Son of God [Jesus].”

Key Bible Passage

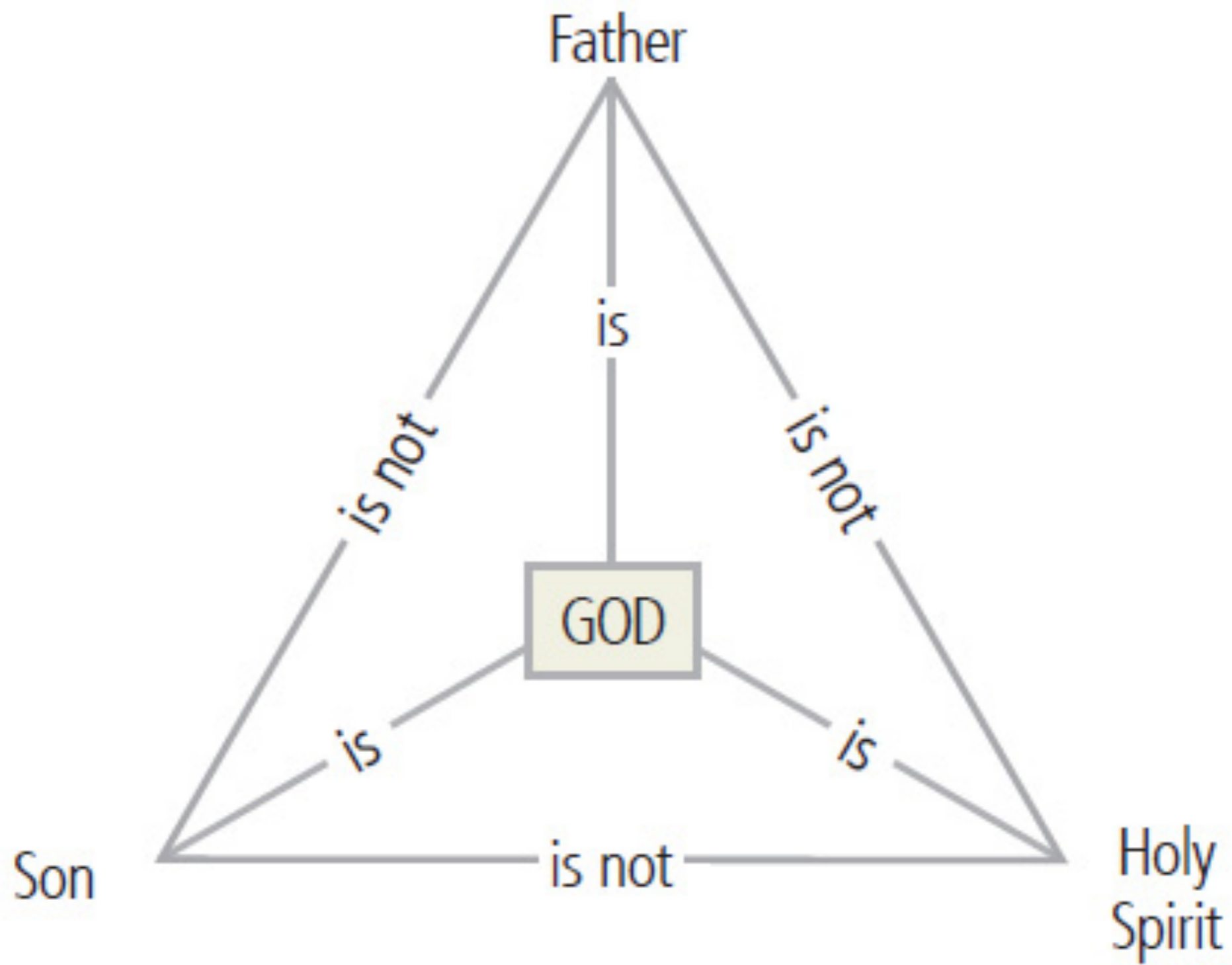
- Matthew 3:16-17, “After his baptism, as Jesus came up out of the water, the heavens were opened and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and settling on him. And a voice from heaven said, ‘This is my dearly loved Son, who brings me great joy.’”

Key Bible Passage

- Matthew 28:19 “Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name (singular noun) of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.”

Key Bible Passage

- 2 Corinthians 13:14, “May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God [Father], and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.”



Relating to God

- There are distinct roles fulfilled by each person of the Godhead such that we can relate to God in a general pattern: to the Father, through the Son, by the Holy Spirit. This will help to keep us humble, loving, worshipful and unified.
