Deception in The Temple

“2 He will exalt himself and defy everything that people call god and every object of worship. **He will even sit in the Temple of God,** claiming that he himself is God...9 This man will come to do the work of Satan with counterfeit power and signs and miracles. 10 He will use every kind of evil deception to fool those on their way to destruction, because they refuse to love and accept the truth that would save them.”
