I. God is within.

1 Corinthians 6:19 NIV "Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, **who is in you**, whom you have received from God?"

John 14:16-17 (NIV) And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever— ¹⁷ the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and **will be in you**.

"Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink? When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you? When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you?'

"The King will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.' III. God wants us to experience him by getting involved with what he is involved with.

Titus 3:14 NASB Our people must also learn to engage in good deeds to meet pressing needs ...
