When will the evidence for Jesus as Lord ever be enough?

Bible Facts for Faith:

- "A Reliable Collection of Historical Documents
 - —written by Eye-Witnesses during the Lifetime of Other Eye-Witnesses
 - —that Record Supernatural Events that are in Fulfillment of Specific Prophecy from 500-1,000 Years Earlier—and they Claim that their Writings are Divine rather than Human in Origin."

- Written on 3 different continents (Asia, Africa, Europe)
- Written in 3 different languages, mostly Hebrew and Greek with a little Aramaic
- Collection of 66 Books that add up to approximately 1,400 pages in all.
- Written by 40+ Authors (including kings, generals, historians, fishermen, tax collectors, and one of his absolute greatest skeptics and haters who had previously imprisoned Christians)
 - o Most of these authors lived in various times in history and never met one another.
 - o Jesus did not write a single word himself.
- Written over 1,500 years from the earliest writing to the last and final contribution.
- Writing about hundreds of different subjects and topics and come together in a cohesive unit that tells one redemptive story.
 - And yet, is still Consistent and Logical!!!
- Over 25,000 archeological digs validate historical elements discussed directly in the Bible.
- There are non-biblical texts and historians that verify Jesus' life.

 Historians agree that Jesus was indeed a very real historical figure who was at a minimum, baptized by John the Baptist and crucified.
