Preparing for the Study

1. Begin with prayer.
2. Read Genesis Chapters 3-5

Observations

1. Read Genesis 3:1-5. What is the commandment Eve told Satan that she thought God told them to obey? Compare those words with the actual commandment in Genesis 2:16-17 and explain the differences between the actual commandment and what Eve thought it was.
2. Why did Eve eat the fruit based on Genesis 3:6?
3. Where was Adam? (Genesis 3:6)
4. Why did Adam eat the fruit? Use 1 Timothy 2:14 as a cross reference to try and discern why Adam ate the fruit.
5. After they ate the fruit what did they do? Genesis 3:7-8
6. Briefly summarize the consequence God gave them because of this sin?
 - a. Satan (Gen 3:14-15)
 - b. Women (Gen 3:16)
 - c. Adam (Gen 3:17-19)
7. Summarize what God did in Genesis 3:21-24.
8. In Genesis 4:1-8 What did Abel offer God and what did Cain bring? God didn't accept Cain's offering. Look up Hebrew 9:22 and write why you think God didn't accept Cain's offering.
9. What did Cain do? (Gen 4:8) What should Cain have done?
10. Read Genesis 5 and color all the names in Green and underline the words "**and he died**" in red.
11. Look closely at Enoch in Genesis 5:21-24. How was he different than all the others?

Let's think a little deeper

1. Genesis 3:15 is a promise to us. (A seed is referring to a child) Satan's seed will bruise her seed on the heel, but Eve's seed will bruise Satan's seed on the head. Which one is fatal? Many refer to this as the Gospel. Look up Galatians 3:16 and explain how this is the promise of the Gospel.
