Preparing for the Study

1. Begin with prayer.
2. Read Genesis Chapters 6-10

Observations

1. Record what you find in the following verses why God was angry and sent the flood.
 - a. Genesis 6:1-4
 - b. Genesis 6:5
 - c. Genesis 6:11-12
2. Who was on the Ark with Noah? Gen 7:13-16
3. Some people have claimed it was only a local flood. Using Gen 7:16-20 explain why it was a total earth wide flood.
4. How complete was the flood and how long did the water stay over the land based on Gen 7:21-23?
5. What did Noah do as soon as the Lord told him to leave the Ark? Gen 8:18-20
6. After the flood, God gave Noah and his descendants a command. What was the command and what did God do so that they could obey His command? (Gen 9:1-2)
7. What was God's promise to Noah in Gen 9:11? What was the sign God gave so that He and all descendants of Noah could be reminded God will keep His promise? Gen 9:12-17
8. How old was Noah when the flood came? (Gen 7:11) and how old was Noah when he died? (Gen 9:28-29) This will be interesting in next week's lesson.
9. Read Gen 9:20-29. Why was Shem and Japheth blessed by their father when Ham and his children are cursed?
10. Read Gen 10:6-12. How does this show their disobedience to God's command given in Gen 9:1?

Let's think a little deeper

1. Compare Genesis 6:5 (before the flood) with Genesis 8:21 (after the flood). What is still true of man? If the purpose of the flood was to stop this, it didn't. Ponder what does God want us to consider when we remember the flood. (2 Peter 3:3-7, Matt 24:37-39).
