 - c. What does theses verses say about Jesus Christ? V3-4
 - d. In Verse 5 Paul received grace and apostleship for what purpose? Vs 5
- 3. In Romans 1:8-12 List what things Paul wants the Roman Church to know?
- 4. Paul has been prevented to visit the church in Rome so far (Romans 1:13). Why is Paul eager to visit them? Romans 1:13, 15
- 5. Why is Paul not ashamed of the Gospel? Romans 1:16-17
- 6. Look up Luke 9:26 and Matthew 10:32-33 list what happens to those who are ashamed of the Gospel.
- 7. How are the righteous to live? Romans 1:17 and Habakkuk 2:4
