Preparing for the Study

1. Begin with prayer. You are about to read the words of God. You never want to take it lightly. (2 Timothy 3:16, 2 Peter 1:20-21)
2. Read Romans 1:1-17

Observations

1. This week we are focusing on Romans 1:1-17. Read these verses and use a green color pencil to underline every time the word “faith” is used. We will do this through the entire book of Romans as we study the book.
2. Based on Romans 1:1-7 answer the following questions.
 - a. What do these verses say about Paul? Vs 1
 - b. What do these verses say about the Gospel of God(Good News)? Vs 2
 - c. What do these verses say about Jesus Christ? V3-4
 - d. In Verse 5 Paul received grace and apostleship for what purpose? Vs 5
3. In Romans 1:8-12 List what things Paul wants the Roman Church to know?
4. Paul has been prevented to visit the church in Rome so far (Romans 1:13). Why is Paul eager to visit them? Romans 1:13, 15
5. Why is Paul not ashamed of the Gospel? Romans 1:16-17
6. Look up Luke 9:26 and Matthew 10:32-33 list what happens to those who are ashamed of the Gospel.
7. How are the righteous to live? Romans 1:17 and Habakkuk 2:4

9. Are you able to explain the Gospel clearly to an unbeliever? What should be included?
10. As you begin this study what do you want to learn about in the book of Romans? How do you want to grow in your faith?
