Luke 8:40-48 & Selected Scriptures

**Biblical Joy:** *An unspeakable gladness, a gift from God that refreshes our soul.*

**There was an Issue of Blood** - (Leviticus 15:25-27)

### Doctor, Doctor

**Mark 5:26** *“Had suffered a great deal under the care of many doctors and had spent all she had, yet instead of getting better she grew worse.”*

**Touching the Tassel** - (Numbers 15:37-41; Luke 8:44,47, Malachi 4:1-2)

- *Tassels called tzitzit = 613 commandments in the Torah.*
- *“kanaph” means corners or wings.*

**“Who Touched Me?”** - (Luke 8:45)

- **Jesus Asked for Her Sake. . .**
  1. He asked for her sake so that He could \_\_\_\_\_ her level of *faith*.
  2. He wanted her to know that the healing would be \_\_\_\_\_.
  3. He wanted to establish a \_\_\_\_\_ relationship with her.
- **Jesus Asked for the Crowd’s Sake**
  1. So that Jairus would \_\_\_\_\_ know what God could do.

2. So that the curious onlookers would see His \_\_\_\_\_ fully displayed.
3. He wanted the crowd to know that His \_\_\_\_\_ was not a factor to be touched by the untouchable.

### “Power Has Gone Out From Me”

**Luke 8:46** *“Someone touched Me, for I perceive that power has gone out from Me.”*
