- **Romans 1:16** *For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes. . .*
 - **Power** = dynamite (Romans 5:6,8:3; John 1:2; 1 Corinthians 1:18,23-25; 2:1-4; 4:20; 1 Peter 1:23)
 - **Salvation** = deliverance (Matthew 18:11; Romans 5:9; Hosea 4:6; 2 Thess.1:8; Luke14:26; Colossians 1:13; 1 Peter 2:9; Revelation 20:6)
 - **Believes** = have faith in (Ephesians 2:8; Romans 10:14-17; Romans 6:17; 15:13)
