Philippians 2:5-11 & Selected Scriptures

Introduction:

Biblical Joy: An unspeakable gladness, a gift from God that refreshes our soul.

(Genesis 1:3-5, 6-8, 9-10; 2:19; 17:17,19)

- *Isaac* means -

Isaiah 7:14 *“Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign; Behold, a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel.”*

- *Immanuel* means -

Isaiah 9:6 *“For to us a child is born, to us a Son is given; and the government shall be upon His shoulder, and His Name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.”*

- *Jesus* means -

(John 9:11, 17, 34, 35-38; Philippians 2:5-11)

- **LORD** means -

When we call Jesus Lord . . .

- a. We _____ our love and loyalty to Him.
- b. We _____ down to Christ's ultimate authority in our lives.
- c. We _____ to Him all we are, have, and hope to be.
- d. We _____ our own will and way, and willingly submit to Him.

Conclusion: Lordship means Ownership

2 Corinthians 5:15 *“Either way, Christ's love controls us. Since we believe that Christ died for all, we also believe that we have died to our old life. He died for everyone so that those who receive His new life will no longer live for themselves. Instead, they will live for Christ, who died and was raised for them.”*

- *So who are we living for? Who's really in control of our lives?*
- *Is there a particular possession, attitude, relationship, or ability that you are refusing to place under My Lordship?*
