Sermon: "The End of the Wilderness"

Text: Revelation 21:1-22:5

SUMMARY

When we follow Jesus, the King of Peace, out of the wilderness, we anticipate our arrival in the new heavens and earth and the new city Jerusalem—the place where God dwells with man and our faith becomes sight.

FOR GROUPS

How does our understanding of what God is going to do with the new heavens and new earth affect the way you live currently?

In the new heavens and new earth God will fully dwell among his people. How does this give you hope in the wilderness when God feels far?

Through our series on wilderness we have walked through the wilderness with Israel and lamented with Jeremiah. How does the fact that God is going to wipe away every tear from our eyes and death will be no more transform the way you walk in this present reality?

How does this passage show that God is a god of completion, that is bringing everything to its intended end and purpose? Is there comfort in know that God brings everything to completion? How are you prone to forget or not believe that God will bring about completion?

What does it mean for your faith to become sight? What areas of faith now do you long to fully see and realize?

Spend some time praying that our church would be a church who longs for the new kingdom.
