Sermon: "Worthy of Worship"

Text: Isaiah 66:1-4

SUMMARY

As Christians, we face suffering both cosmic and personal in our lives. This reality of God's people suffering can cause us to doubt the truth of Scripture, but God gives us a beautiful picture of eternity to cling to in Revelation. For all of God's people, he will redeem them through suffering and restore them to his presence, provision, and protection forever, where God will wipe away every tear.

FOR FAMILIES

FOR GROUPS

How does our worship of the unworthy demonstrate the aspects of God we fail to recognize?

What areas of our lives need to be reexamined so that we can see them as worship of God's character and provisions? Have you ever served the Church or a fellow brother or sister in Christ with an empty heart? How has this affected the service or robbed you of the joy of giving?

How can we develop a healthy fear of God's wrath while still seeking to worship Him for wholeness of His character? Is it difficult to praise His love and His justice?
