WHY DO YOU THINK IT IS IMPORTANT THAT JESUS WAS TEMPTED IN EVERY WAY, BUT DID NOT DO ANYTHING WRONG?

HOW SHOULD WE APPROACH GOD WHEN WE HAVE BIG FEELINGS?

HOW DO YOU KNOW GOD CARES ABOUT HOW WE FEEL?

USE THE GIANT EARS PRINTABLE

HAVE THE KIDS CUT THE EARS OUT AND DECORATE THEM AS THEY WANT. GIVE THEM A STRIP OF PAPER AND HAVE THEM WRITE THE BIG IDEA ON THE PAPER. STAPLE THIS STRIP OF PAPER IN A CIRCLE TO MAKE A HEADBAND AND ATTACH THE EARS TO IT.

IT'S IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER THAT GOD LISTENS WHEN WE HAVE BIG FEELINGS.

AS A REMINDER. WE ARE GOING TO MAKE GIANT EARS TO REMIND US THAT GOD IS ALWAYS LISTENING TO US.

No matter what's happening to us and how we're feeling about it, we can talk to God! We can be confident that God knows every feeling we may have.

We never have to hide our feelings from God, and we can trust that God will never make fun of us or leave us because of the way we feel.

1 Then Job replied: Chapter 23:1-7 Verse

2 "Even today my complaint is bitter; his hand is heavy in spite of my groaning.


3 If only I knew where to find him; if only I could go to his dwelling!

4 I would state my case before him and fill my mouth with arguments.

5 I would find out what he would answer me, and consider what he would say to me.

6 Would he vigorously oppose me? No, he would not press charges against me.

7 There the upright can establish their innocence before him, and there I would be delivered forever from my judge.
