Verse

- 1 Then the Lord spoke to Job out of the storm. He said:
- 2 “Who is this that obscures my plans with words without knowledge?
- 3 Brace yourself like a man; I will question you, and you shall answer me.
- 4 “Where were you when I laid the earth’s foundation? Tell me, if you understand.
- 5 Who marked off its dimensions? Surely you know!
Who stretched a measuring line across it?
- 6 On what were its footings set, or who laid its cornerstone—
- 7 while the morning stars sang together and all the angels shouted for joy?

- 34 “Can you raise your voice to the clouds and cover yourself with a flood of water?
- 35 Do you send the lightning bolts on their way? Do they report to you, ‘Here we are’?
- 36 Who gives the ibis wisdom or gives the rooster understanding?

Verse



46 Then they came to Jericho. As Jesus and his disciples, together with a large crowd, were leaving the city, a blind man, Bartimaeus (which means “son of Timaeus”), was sitting by the roadside begging.

47 When he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to shout, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!”

48 Many rebuked him and told him to be quiet, but he shouted all the more, “Son of David, have mercy on me!”

49 Jesus stopped and said, “Call him.”

So they called to the blind man, “Cheer up! On your feet! He’s calling you.”

50 Throwing his cloak aside, he jumped to his feet and came to Jesus.

51 “What do you want me to do for you?” Jesus asked him.

The blind man said, “Rabbi, I want to see.”

52 “Go,” said Jesus, “your faith has healed you.”

Immediately he received his sight and followed Jesus along the road.
