Sticky Statement: You feed them!

Passage: Mark 6:30-44, Jesus feeds the 5000

We all want to be the kind of people who give more than we take. But we struggle to manage our “what about me?”

How can we grow as servant-hearted people?

1. See with _____. (v.30-36)

Jesus saw the crowds with compassion! The disciples saw the crowd as an inconvenience because of how they held their hunger.

Felt Need + Feeling Forgotten → Selfishness

Jesus sees you this morning, *with compassion*. Full stop. AND he invites you into his way of seeing where, in faith that we are not forgotten and He is enough, we can see others *even while we have need*.

What if our church was a place to be seen, and see, with compassion?

2. Give with _____.

v.37, “record scratch” moment—“*You feed them!*”

They were defensive and incredulous because there was no way they could meet the need on their own. *That is exactly why Jesus said this!*

Jesus calls them to see what they *do* have, and place it in his hands—to give with faith.

3. Enjoy _____ Together.

This moment became a work of art, magnifying Jesus more than the disciples, the crowd, or the act itself.

Their meager portion before they gave it to Jesus wouldn't have been enough to satisfy them anyways!
