“Now FAITH is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen...⁶ And without FAITH it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.” Hebrews 11:1, 6

Have you ever questioned your salvation or wondered “Am I even saved?” Me, too! Why is this important? You can’t mature if you are insecure. Satan creates doubts. Throughout the ages, there have been discussions about this topic. For understanding of insecurity, look to family of origin, religious experiences, and life events.

1. Common Concern (1 John 5:11)

“And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.” 1 John 5:11

The word **“witness”** (mar-too-ree'-ah) is like when you say, “Gma makes the best fried chicken! Can I get a witness? Or Aunt Bessie’s peach cobbler is to die for.” We get the English word martyr. It’s a legal term. This verse is like a restatement of John 3:16 or Romans 6:23, “the free gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord”.

2. Cling to Jesus. (1 John 5:12)

“The one who has the Son has the life; the one who does not have the Son of God does not have the life” (v. 12).

The word “have” (ekh'-o) is a present active participle meaning “clinging to.” The one clinging to the Son clings to life (dzo-ay'), which means life real/genuine.
