#### Sticky Statement: Worship requires more than a song.

Passage: John 4:19-23

"19"Sir," the woman said, "I can see that you are a prophet. 20Our ancestors worshiped on this mountain, but you Jews claim that the place where we must worship is in Jerusalem."

21 "Woman," Jesus replied, "believe me, a time is coming when you will worship the Father neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem. 22You Samaritans worship what you do not know; we worship what we do know, for salvation is from the Jews. 23Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. – John 4:19–23

#### **Worship**

"Proskuneo" which means to kneel and to kiss the hand.

#### 1. We Worship the Father in $\underline{\text{Truth}}$ . (V 23)

6"I am the way, and <u>the truth</u>, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. - John 14:6

#### **Truth**

"aletheia" which means what is certain, what is fact, what is real.

10The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly. - John 10:10

## 2. We Worship the Father in <u>Spirit</u> (V 23)

- c. **Gratitude toward Him** (Luke 17:11-19)
