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EZEKIEL 47:1-5

“God brought me back to the entrance to the temple, and I saw water coming out from under the threshold of the temple toward the east (for the temple faced east). The water was coming down from under the south side of the temple, south of the altar. He then brought me out through the north gate and led me around the outside to the outer gate facing east, and the water was trickling from the south side.

As God went eastward with a measuring line in his hand, He led me through water that was ankle-deep. We walked further and He led me through water that was knee-deep. Further still, He led me through water up to the waist. He led me again but now it was a river that I could not cross.”

WE INVITE YOU TO PARTICIPATE IN OVERFLOW IN TWO POWERFUL WAYS:

1. 100% Engagement from Everyone Who Calls Connection Home

This vision is too big for a few; it will take all of us. If Connection Church is your home, we're asking you to prayerfully consider how you can be part of this move of God. We're not just building walls; we're building legacy. Our children and youth are growing, and we're out of space to serve them well. This is our moment to pay it forward, to invest in the next generation and beyond. Whether your role is giving, praying, serving, or sharing the vision, your participation matters. When the whole body moves together, we become unstoppable. Let's rise together in unity and faith to see this vision fulfilled.

2. Two Years of Generosity from God's Overflow to You

ENTRYWAY

As part of our OVERFLOW expansion, we're excited to unveil a beautifully designed new entryway that reflects both hospitality and holiness. This welcoming space will feature a covered drop-off area, making arrival easy and comfortable for families, rain or shine. At the heart of the entrance stands a towering cross, a bold and beautiful reminder that Jesus is the center of everything we do. Just steps inside, you'll find seating areas thoughtfully created to foster connection, conversation, and community.





CHILDREN'S SPACES

We're also creating a dedicated **children's expansion** designed with safety, creativity, and spiritual growth at its core. This new area will feature **brand-new classrooms** and a nursery tailored to each age group, along with **remodeled ministry spaces** that are vibrant, engaging, and full of life. To ensure comfort and security, **new bathrooms will be located inside the protected children's wing**, allowing kids to stay within a safe environment throughout their time at church.

YOUTH SPACES

We'll be building a **brand-new worship auditorium and activities building** tailored specifically for our teenagers. This dynamic space will be a hub for worship, discipleship, and connection, complete with **large bathrooms** and areas designed for both large gatherings and small group moments. We're also renovating the **teen café and game room**, creating a fresh, fun, and welcoming environment where students can hang out, build friendships, and grow in their faith. MALLWAY AND AUDITORIUM

We desire to expand the **Mallway** to create a more spacious and inviting environment for fellowship and connection. This expanded area will feature a **renovated café**, perfect for grabbing coffee, meeting with friends, or welcoming new guests. We're also adding new **riser seating** to our current auditorium, increasing capacity by **300 additional seats** to make room for more people to experience worship and the Word. THE JOURNEY OF GENEROSITY



There are five stages that we see many people grow in their generosity. These are not steps to ascend in order to get closer to God but simply a way to consider how we can grow in our generosity. We are encouraged to grow in the grace of giving (2 Corinthians 8:7). **Where would you say you are?**

The Initial Giver is someone who decides to give for the first time out of response to God's Word about giving. This is someone who decides to give something and trust God and the leaders of the Church with this gift. They experience the joy of putting Jesus' words into action. (2 Corinthians 9:7)

generosity each month before they spend or save for anything else. They seek to honor God with 100% of what He has given them, whether that be through monetary giving or God-honoring use of their time, talent, treasure, and resources.

A Consistent Giver is someone who decides to begin giving regularly. This person realizes that God is the owner and we are the stewards of all He gives us and regularly gives back a portion of what He has entrusted to them. Often, someone who decides to make their gift an online recurring gift will be someone who is learning the joy of consistency. Non-online givers can also be consistent givers; it just requires more discipline.

An Eternal Giver is someone who thinks about the eternal impact their giving can have and how it can change not only them but the lives of so many others. The eternal impact their generosity might have gives them so much more joy than anything they could ever buy for themselves. An Eternal Giver might be someone who has a lifetime giving goal that governs what home they buy, what car they purchase, and how much savings they choose to keep. They desire to leave a legacy, make a difference in this world, and allow God's Kingdom purposes to govern their spending more than their own kingdoms. They want to be "rich in good works, supremely generous, always ready to share, and have stored up their full treasure in heaven so that they may take hold of that which is truly life." (1 Tim 6:18-19)

A Surrendered Giver is someone who recognizes that Christ surrendered Himself totally for us in dying on the cross for our sins. Therefore, the Surrendered Giver desires to surrender their whole life to Jesus out of love for all he has done for them. This giver deliberately tithes and seeks to be generous above and beyond when possible. They set aside their gifts of

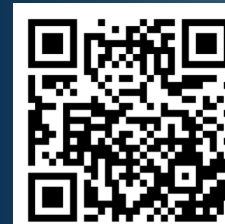
October 2025 – A preaching series on generosity
