### Matthew 28:1–7 (NLT)

- 1** Early on Sunday morning, as the new day was dawning, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went out to visit the tomb.
- 2** Suddenly there was a great earthquake! For an angel of the Lord came down from heaven, rolled aside the stone, and sat on it.
- 3** His face shone like lightning, and his clothing was as white as snow.
- 4** The guards shook with fear when they saw him, and they fell into a dead faint.
- 5** Then the angel spoke to the women. “Don’t be afraid!” he said. “I know you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified.
- 6** He isn’t here! He is risen from the dead, just as he said would happen. Come, see where his body was lying.
- 7** And now, go quickly and tell his disciples that he has risen from the dead, and he is going ahead of you to Galilee. You will see him there. Remember what I have told you.”

## 1 Corinthians 15:17–19 (NLT)

**17** And if Christ has not been raised, then your faith is useless and you are still guilty of your sins.

**18** In that case, all who have died believing in Christ are lost!

**19** And if our hope in Christ is only for this life, we are more to be pitied than anyone in the world.

## John 2:19–21 (NLT)

**19** “All right,” Jesus replied. “Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.”

**20** “What!” they exclaimed. “It has taken forty-six years to build this Temple, and you can rebuild it in three days?”

**21** But when Jesus said “this temple,” he meant his own body.

## Matthew 12:39–40 (NLT)

**39** But Jesus replied, “Only an evil, adulterous generation would demand a miraculous sign; but the only sign I will give them is the sign of the prophet Jonah.

**40** For as Jonah was in the belly of the great fish for three days and three nights, so will the Son of Man be in the heart of the earth for three days and three nights.

## John 10:17–18 (NLT)

**17** “The Father loves me because I sacrifice my life so I may take it back again.

**18** No one can take my life from me. I sacrifice it voluntarily. For I have the authority to lay it down when I want to and also to take it up again. For this is what my Father has commanded.”

## Matthew 28:6 (NLT)

**6** He isn't here! He is risen from the dead, just as he said would happen. Come, see where his body was lying.

## Mark 16:7 (NKJV)

**7** But go, tell His disciples—and Peter—that He is going before you into Galilee; there you will see Him, as He said to you.”

## 1 Peter 1:5–8 (NKJV)
