John 17.13-21 NASB on Screen

- Jesus' vision is that we would experience joy and live in joy
- He wants us to be free from the evil one
- We are to be set apart by truth (the Word of God)
- Sanctification is transformation
- Jesus wants unity. That we would be one. That we would be "all together"

God Moves, and Kingdom Goals are Accomplished when Jesus' Followers are "All-Together"

*"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life, and have it **abundantly**."* (John 10:10, NASB95)

*"And He called the twelve **together**, and gave them power and authority over all the demons and to heal diseases."* (Luke 9:1, NASB95)

"When the apostles returned, they gave an account to Him of all that they had done. Taking them with Him, He withdrew by Himself to a city called Bethsaida. But the crowds were aware of this and followed Him; and welcoming them, He began speaking to them about the kingdom of God and curing those who had need of healing." (Luke 9:10-11, NASB95)

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"When they had been released, they went to their own companions and reported all that the chief priests and the elders had said to them." (Acts 4:23, NASB95)

Acts 4.24-31

"And when they had prayed, the place where they had gathered all- together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak the word of God with boldness." (Acts 4:31, NASB95)
