1. Read Psalm 103:6-13

⁶The LORD performs righteous deeds And judgments for all who are oppressed.

⁷He made known His ways to Moses, His acts to the sons of Israel.

⁸The LORD is compassionate and gracious, Slow to anger and abounding in lovingkindness.

⁹He will not always strive with us, Nor will He keep His anger forever.

¹⁰He has not dealt with us according to our sins, Nor rewarded us according to our iniquities.

¹¹For as high as the heavens are above the earth, So great is His lovingkindness toward those who fear Him.

¹²As far as the east is from the west, So far has He removed our transgressions from us.

¹³Just as a father has compassion on his children, So the LORD has compassion on those who fear Him. What attributes in this verses describe our Heavenly Father?

- 3. Wendy shared about the compassion of our Father. When have you experienced God's compassion before? (either upon you, or through you to others?)
- 4. Why is it hard for many to view God as compassionate, loving, and full of grace?
- 5. Matthew 5.48 quotes Jesus saying *Therefore you are to be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect*No one is perfect. Was what Pastor Nate said about this new to you? What did you think of his comments?
- 6. Why is it comforting to know God is stable?

 "For I, the LORD, do not change; ..." Malachi 3:6
- 7. Read Proverbs 3.5-6. How is this verse powerful to us with a Father we can trust?
- 8. When is it hardest to sense Father's presence? Why? How can that be approached?
- 9. Romans 8.15 "For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!"

Father is our Father. He is yours. You can call him "dad". This can be a game-changer for your life and walk. Your view of Father, affects your faith in Him. How does this truth lead you to God's goodness?
