What is a miracle?

An event remarkable in that it goes contrary to the laws of nature, that is, to the usual course of events It is an act not fully explained by natural forces, science, reason, or culture and it is attributed to the intervention and sovereign work of God our Father.

Seven Components for a Miracle

- 1. Go to the Word. Lean into the promises.
- 2. Ask according to the Bible
- 3. Prepare to give God the credit
- 4. Give God your all.
- 5. Don't hinge your love for God on the Yes to your miracle.
- 6. Lean into your faith Keep believing, keep loving,
- 7. Keep watching with expectancy.
