- 2. He taught what the Kingdom of God was like.
- 3. He manifested the presence of the Kingdom of God in events that could not be explained in a natural way.

2. We live in the Kingdom of God when we realize God is active in our lives.

3. We live in the Kingdom of God when we value God's activity in others' lives.

- Think of your life, choices, priorities, money, and relationship and ask if they are glorifying the King?
- Think about those you love; can you pray God's will for their lives? Take a moment and pray.
- 4. Jeremiah 29:13 "You will seek Me and find Me when you search for Me with all your heart."
- Have you settled with just believing in God, and not seeking the Kingdom of God, and King Jesus in your life?
- What are the personal benefits of seeking Jesus and living in the kingdom?
- How does this affect your marriage or singleness? Family and friends? Habits and affections?
- 5. Pastor Nate taught us how to live in the Kingdom and how God's Kingdom comes into our lives as it is in Heaven.
- Take time to prayerfully review each point and reflect on the question for thought and prayer.

• Sometimes we focus on behavior and not the heart. How is your heart? Read Proverbs 4.23
