Jesus is the Arm of the Lord

Jesus is the tender shoot promised

Jesus was a man of Sorrows v. 3

Acquainted with grief

Isaiah 53.4-7 Jesus bore our griefs. These are "now" "not yet"

Griefs= sickness, suffering, weakness

Jesus carried our sorrows

Sorrows in Hebrew mean internal pain and suffering

""These things I have spoken to you, so that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation, but take courage; I have overcome the world."" (John 16:33, NASB95)

Jesus was crushed for our iniquities (5)

By His stripes we are Healed

The God who heals: Jehovah Rapha. We are repaired, cured, forgiven, and purified.

"He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He did not open His mouth; Like a lamb that is led to slaughter, And like a sheep that is silent before its shearers, So He did not open His mouth." (Isaiah 53:7, NASB95)
