Ice-Breaker: Share any thought about the service on Sunday

1. JP said some people do not fulfill their destiny, or God's will for their life. Why is this true? How can this happen?
2. What are some things you know about Peter?
3. Does "Fearless Faith" like Peter, expressed in John 13.36-37 diminish the longer we are believers? What do you think?
4. Peter failed. We all fail. Read 1 John 1.9 and talk about what God is saying to us in this Scripture?
5. How is this a game-changer when we do fail?
6. JP said fear of failure can prevent us, or stop us in doing what the Lord would have us. Have you experienced this? Share?
7. Read John 20.6-8. John believed but Peter did not. How can you relate to Peter?
8. Peter decided to go fishing after the resurrection in John 21.1-4. JP said Peter was living in fear and not faith and it was becoming a way of life. He may have believed he was no longer useable by God, because of his failure.

How can we all relate to Peter?

How can we get out of that deceptive mindset?

How can we live and walk in truth?

9. Jesus restores Peter (John 21.15-21). Read this and share what this tells us about our God?
