- 1. Read John 13.31-14.6
- 2. Why do you think Jesus gave a new commandment? How is this different than Leviticus 19.18?
- 3. Read 1 John 4.7-8. What dynamics makes this a challenge and how can we fulfill this (see 1 John 4.19)?
- 4. John 13.35: Jesus teaches that love of one another will show we are the followers of Jesus. How do you express love to others? How do you communicate? What do you do that is loving?
- 5. When Jesus gave Peter that prophetic declaration of his denial, how do you think he felt?
- 6. The disciples were troubled by the disclosure by Jesus. How did he comfort them?
- 7. How does John 14.1-4 apply to us?
- ""Do not let your heart be troubled; believe in God, believe also in Me. "In My Father's house are many dwelling places; if it were not so, I would have told you; for I go to prepare a place for you. "If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also. "And you know the way where I am going."" (John 14:1–4, NASB95)
