Kings over Israel and Judah

- Saul was the first King of Israel, he of course did evil and David was anointed king.
- There were 40 Kings of Judah and Israel.
- Seven (7) were Godly, 28 did evil in the eyes of the Lord (17.5%) were good kings
- 5 started good and ended bad, like Solomon, Joash, Amazaiah, Jehu

4. Matthew 18.21-22 Our King commands us to live in Forgiveness
